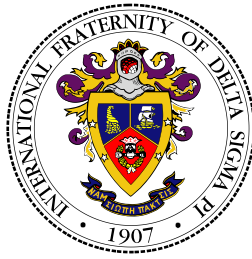

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

PRE-PLEDGING REQUIREMENTS:

- Minimum of 15 hours of college credit completed to date. Minimum of two semesters left.
- Full time enrollment and pursuant of a business degree at university.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- Not a member of any other professional business fraternity.
- Mandatory Interview on Sunday, February 13, 2011. Professional dress required. Must submit resume and class/work schedule.
- Available Wednesday, February 16, 2011 for Preliminary Pledge Meeting.

Please complete the application for membership using accurate and thorough information. Attach additional pages, such as resume and other requested information. The completed application must be submitted by **Saturday, February 12, 2011, 5:00 p.m.** Your application for membership will be completed if it includes the following information:

Please provide a current resume detailing your experience, academic background, and relevant campus/community activities and involvement. Include scholarships, honors, awards, and leadership positions.

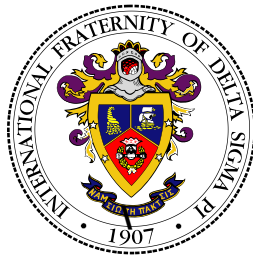
3. CLASS SCHEDULE / WORK SCHEDULE

MEMBERSHIP IN DELTA SIGMA PI



PRE-PLEDGING REQUIREMENTS:

- Minimum of 15 hours of college credit completed to date. Minimum of two semesters left.
- Full time enrollment and pursuant of a business degree at university.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- Not a member of any other professional business fraternity.

PLEDGE REQUIREMENTS:

- Payment of Pledging Dues: \$136.00
- Attendance at all pledge meetings. Professional dress is required. Date and time to be determined.
- Successful completion of a 10 week pledging process including the following:
 - Attendance at one pledge fundraiser.
 - Attendance at one pledge community service event.
 - Attendance at one professional speaker event organized by the pledge class.
 - Attendance at one pledge social event.
 - Knowledge of the fraternity history, governing legislation, and tradition.
 - Attend at least one chapter meeting and 25% of chapter's professional and community service events.
- Attendance at Initiation Ceremony in April.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

- Payment of Chapter Dues: \$85.00 per semester
- Attendance at chapter meetings; usually held every Wednesday night of academic semester.
- Participation in all fraternal obligations and requirements including but not limited to:
 - Professional activities
 - Community service activities
 - Recruitment events
 - Fundraising activities
- Adhering to the fraternity oath, bylaws, risk management policy, and governing procedures.
